### **Attention Laser Sailors (and other small boats at club)**

We are excited there is a growing fleet of lasers and small boats on the grass at the club and boats are being sailed!

Per our operating procedures, "Lasers and other small sailboats stored for any amount of time shall pay the appropriate fee. Fees were due by April 1 on the membership form. If after April 1 a member decides to store a boat in the area, it is the member's responsibility to pay the fee."

We are so grateful to the house committee for the new kids' room decor and all new games and game tables this past spring. After a repair due to damage in the kids' room, which occurred during Saturday's evening social event, we ask all parents to take a moment to review the following guidelines:

## Kids' Room Guidelines for Parents & Guardians

### 1. SUPERVISE

Parents of children who are age 4 and younger should be within eyesight of their children at all times.

Parents of kids age 5 & up should check in often to ensure that their children are acting responsibly.

### 2. SET EXPECTATIONS

Parents should meet with their children to discuss expectations on how to take care of this area- including furniture, games, toys, and sports equipment. Remind the children not to set drinks, wet swimsuits or towels on any wood or fabric. Show them where trashcans are and encourage them to help keep the area clean.

Encourage children to go and get an adult if they see behavior that is dangerous to others, or to our facility.

"If you see something, say something!"

### 3. FOLLOW THROUGH

Please check the kids' room before you leave each event to ensure that your children haven't left anything out.

It is the member's responsibility to share this information with guests upon each visit.
