Attention Laser Sailors (and other small boats at club)

We are excited there is a growing fleet of lasers and small boats on the grass at the club and boats are being sailed!

Per our operating procedures, "Lasers and other small sailboats stored for any amount of time shall pay the appropriate fee. Fees were due by April 1 on the membership form. If after April 1 a member decides to store a boat in the area, it is the member's responsibility to pay the fee."

If you have a boat on the lawn and have not paid the appropriate fee, please email the treasurer so you can be properly invoiced.

Additionally, please remember that all boats, covers, and dollies need to have a member name and sail number on them. Tires need to be kept inflated, and cockpits free of water. This does not apply to storage of kayaks and paddle boards on the designated rack.

(DCLSA Standard Operating Procedures 2.4, Dry Storage of Boats)

Junior Progeny: shall be persons under 30 years of age as of April 30th and a progeny of a current Voting Membership at the time of becoming a member. Upon reaching 30 years of age, (any one person of a Membership), membership class will automatically transfer to Progeny.
