

Draft Operating Procedures Amendments

1.3 Mug Room

(a) No one under the age of 21 years is permitted to be in the Mug Room except to pass through between the clubhouse and pavilion. Under no circumstances shall anyone under the age of 21 congregate in, eat in, access the soda machine, or go behind the bar of the Mug Room.

(b) Only members age 21 years or older are permitted behind the bar. Under no circumstances shall guests be permitted behind the bar. Members shall serve their guests all wine or beer and only members may pour wine or beer.

(c) All members are responsible for bussing their own tables and making sure that all plates, cutlery, and glassware are brought to the dirty dish area. Glasses and other dishes may not be left in the Mug Room sink, on the bar, or around the clubhouse grounds.

1.6 Private Events

(g) All fees shall be paid at least 14 days prior to the private event. Failure to timely prepay for the event may result in the cancellation of the event in the sole discretion of the Board.

4.3 Courtesy Extended to Non-Members

(a) Guests, including band members and social event attendees, must be in the company of a Membership who shall remain on the premises with the guests and assume full responsibility for their conduct and expenditures. Guest privileges for any individual guest are limited to a maximum of four days per year. Guests include children of a Membership 26 years of age or older and not a full-time student.

(b) An exception to the four-day limit on guest visits may apply to (1) family of a Membership living out of the local area and visiting the Membership for a limited period of time and (2) a significant other of a Membership.

(c) Members may apply for good-cause exceptions to the rules under § 4.3 by application in advance to the Board through the House Chair. The Board will consider such requests on a case-by-case basis and, if granted, shall send waivers in writing.

5.11 Reciprocal Member Procedure

The Board shall issue invitations, under Bylaws § 5.2(b)(2) to any Corporate Member in good standing of the Deep Creek Yacht Club at Deerhaven who requests reciprocal membership and provides all application information necessary for Membership Chair and member directory purposes. Upon invitation and payment of the fee, the applicant shall become a reciprocal member.
